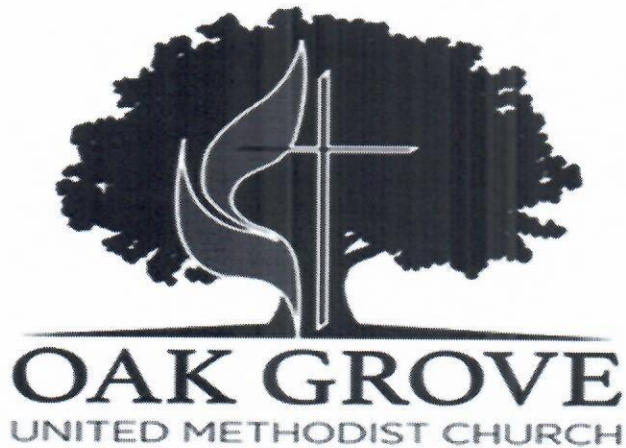




Oak Grove UMC In-Person Worship Procedures

1. Access to enter the church will be limited to the front door and the side door under the portico.
2. At each door we will have hand sanitizer for each person to use upon entering and exiting the building and face masks available for anyone who does not have one.
3. Each person will be asked to wear their masks or may not be permitted inside the sanctuary. ** Please remember this action is for everyone's protection and safety.
4. Please remember that your masks need to be on and worn properly when you are in motion and moving around and when you are in conversation with others.
5. We will have a security team member and a Worship team member at each entrance to help with making sure everyone has a mask and is following safety standards.
6. Please remember to avoid hugging and handshakes.
7. When the benediction is given please be seated and the ushers will let you know when you can exit.
8. No congregating in the Foyer. Please make your way outdoors when church is over.
9. As always, we strongly encourage those who are at risk and have pre-existing conditions to continue to watch via our livestream and not come at this time to stay safe.
10. Lastly, please remember that these guidelines are set in place for everyone's safety and well being. If you feel you cannot follow these steps, please continue to worship with us via our livestream broadcast.



QUESTIONNAIRE FOR EACH WORSHIP ATTENDEE BEFORE COMING
TO WORSHIP EACH SUNDAY

If you (or someone in your household) answer yes to ANY of the questions below, you should not attend in-person worship until you are sure that you are well to avoid potentially infecting other church members.

- ** Do you have chills and temperate (greater than 100 degrees)?
- ** Have you taken any fever reducing medicine in the past 4-6 hours?
- ** Do you have a cough?
- ** Do you have a sore throat?
- ** Are you experiencing shortness of breath?
- ** Are you experiencing any acute digestive symptoms such as diarrhea, loss of appetite or vomiting?
- ** Are you experiencing a loss of taste or smell?
- ** Have you been in contact with someone with or under investigation for COVID in the past two (2) weeks?
